

## Introduction

The remote digital operator kit allows a digital operator to be mounted up to 3 meters from the GPD315/V7. The kit includes:

- 1. One digital operator interface attachment
- 2. One gasket
- 3. One Digital Operator
- 4. Four screws & nuts
- 5. Eight rubber washers
- 6. One cable, either 1 meter (DS081) or a 3 meters (DS083) in length.

## Hardware Installation

## WARNING

## HAZARDOUS VOLTAGE CAN CAUSE SEVERE INJURY OR DEATH. LOCK ALL POWER SOURCES DRIVE IN "OFF" POSITION.

- 1. Disconnect all electrical power to Drive.
- 2. Verify power has been disconnected by using a voltmeter to check for voltage at incoming power terminals (L1, L2, and L3).
- 3. Wait for the DC bus capacitors to completely discharge.
- 4. Remove contents from package. Verify that the above mentioned parts are included:
- 5. Remove existing Digital Operator from the drive. First, remove the screw on the front cover of the drive, and then pull off the bottom front cover. After this has been completed, remove the Digital Operator from the drive.
- 6. Replace the Digital Operator with the Digital Operator interface. Then re-attach the bottom front cover and tighten the screw down.

Flush Mounting. Mount the Digital Operator as follows.





Figure 1.1 (Dimensions in Inches, not actual size)

1. Cut the Remote Operator mounting panel as shown in Fig. 1.1

2. Install the Remote Operator on the front side of the panel. Use four stainless screws and four rubber washers (one rubber washer per screw). See Figure 1.2





**Surface Mounting**. Mount the Digital Operator as follows.





Figure 2.1 (Dimensions in Inches, not actual size)

1. Cut the Remote Operator mounting panel as shown in Fig. 2.1

2. Apply the gasket to the front side of the digital operator. Install the remote operator from the rear side of panel. Insert the screws through the front side of the panel and then mount the washers and nuts to the rear side of the panel. Tighten screws gradually from the front side of panel. Refer to figure 2.2 for further installation directions.

This completes the installation process.
